

**ROMANS 6:1-14**  
**GROUP DISCUSSION**  
**WEEK 1**

1. If your group is new, or new people have joined, take a few minutes to get introduced. If your group is re-gathering, share a joy or challenge in your life since you last met together.

3. Hand out the Romans journals. Read Romans 6:1-14 out loud in your group.
4. Vs. 1 says “Should we sin that grace may abound?” Do people still have this objection today? How might this attitude surface in the church today?
5. When Paul says in verse 7 that we have died to sin, **does that mean that we will never sin again?** What is he saying?
6. What does it look like for sin to have dominion over us, even as Christians? **What are the reasons we might give sin that power?**
7. Even if you have a ways to go, describe how God has changed your desires since you came to Christ. Is there something you used to delight in that you don’t anymore?
8. Read John 8:31-38. How do Jesus’ words relate to what Paul says in Romans 6? Overall, how do Romans 6 and John 8 encourage you?
9. Over the next week, read Romans 6:15-23 in your journal. Write down any questions or thoughts about it in the journal space. Bring the journal to church on Sunday to take notes. We will discuss it the next time we meet.
