

**GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE**  
**ROMANS 10**  
**WEEK 8**

1. Read Romans 10:1-13

- Contrast the two basic ways of righteousness described here (Paul contrasts them also in Galatians 3:1-14 if you want more help with this).
- Verses 6-8 can be a little confusing to us, but Paul is quoting from Deuteronomy 30:11-14. Read those verses and discuss together the point Paul is getting at.
- In verse 9, what does it mean to confess Jesus as Lord? What are the implications in our life?

2. Read Romans 10:14-21.

- Paul's basic point in this passage is that the Jewish nation as a whole did hear and understand the gospel but the vast majority have rejected it and now it is going out to the whole world. What questions does this bring up for you?
- Does the preaching of the gospel still humble the proud and lift up the lowly today? Why or why not?

- What connection do you see between this video and Romans 10?
- Pastor Mark talked about sharing Christ in 3 parts: The problem, the Solution, and Our Response. As a group, walk through each part and how you might explain it to an unbeliever.
- Who has God put on your heart to pray for that they may be saved?
