

LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION - WEEK 1
ROMANS 12:3-8

1. If you are a new group, take time to get introduced to one another. If you are re-gathering, share an update on something new or different in your life.
2. Read Romans 12:1-3. Paul says the first way we should think differently is to not think too highly of ourselves but rather measure ourselves through the lens of gospel faith. What do you think he means by that?
3. Do you think you do that consistently? Why or why not?
4. Read Romans 12:4-8. What is something that stands out to you in this passage?
5. If you are serving somewhere in the church, do you feel you are using your gifts? If you are not yet serving, what area of service might align with your gifts?
6. We can also use our gifts right here in our own group. Consider these possibilities and take volunteers for each if applicable: Meals/refreshment coordinator, rotate leading discussion or hosting the group, Prayer coordinator (record the requests and text them out, or even lead the prayer time), social coordinator (outside the group time).
7. This passage reminds us that the church is a body where we not only give but receive. Go around and have each person briefly share a need. Maybe a need for wisdom or direction or strength or comfort or even practical help. Then take time to pray for one another.
8. For next week, read Romans 12:9-13 multiple times making notes in your journal about what God is saying to you.
