

LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE
ROMANS 13:8-14

1. Last week we discussed three ways we should relate to government: be subject, be respectful, be involved. How did that go for you? Any examples to share?
2. While we have obligations to government, we have an even larger obligation to love. Read Romans 13: 8-10.
 - What stands out to you in this passage?
 - What does it look like to love continuously rather than occasionally?
 - Where is God stretching you right now as you learn to love others better?
4. Read Romans 13:11. What do you think Paul is talking about? What do we need to wake up to and be more aware of?
5. Read Romans 13:12-14. What is something you took off when you came to Christ? How has taking that thing off opened the way to love others better?
6. What are some practical examples of not “making provision for the flesh”.
7. In the sermon we focused on the four ways God changes us: Learn to love, Wake up, put off old habits and put on new ones, stop feeding the flesh. Which one is most challenging for you?
