

LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION - WEEK 2
Ephesians: God's Plan for God's People
Ephesians 2:1-10

1. Read Ephesians 2:1-10. What is a masterpiece you have experienced? (Art, Film, music, book, experience, etc)
2. What is something from the passage that stood out to you?
3. The “religion” of many people is the idea that if my good outweighs my bad, God will accept me. God rewards nice people who try their best. How is the gospel, as described in this passage, very different from that?
4. What was it like when you first heard and received the gospel? How does your experience reflect what Paul describes in these verses?
5. Pastor Paul challenged us to keep reminding ourselves of the good news. What would it look like for me to do that? Where do I tend to struggle with fully accepting grace?
6. Verse 10 says we are God's masterpiece created in Christ Jesus to do the good things he planned for us. Do I understand the good things he has planned for me and am I doing them?
